Was kann ich bei euch studieren?

Our current economic and socio-political landscape is characterized by increasingly complex globalization, numerous trouble spots, unethical practices in business and politics, and a lack of sustainability in many areas, demanding holistic and interdisciplinary solution perspectives. In the Karls' Social TransFormation degree, students from a wide variety of backgrounds approach topics such as the common good, social movements, migration, war and peace, power and conflict, multiple crises, sustainability, and alternative ways of doing business and living. This includes developing the ability to examine complex, even transnational, contexts and problems.

Wie macht mich das Studium future-fit?

In this program, students develop well-founded knowledge and novel insights while developing creative solutions to modern challenges, acting in a sustainable and ethically reflected manner, shaping relationships, taking on leadership tasks, and actively assuming roles and comprehensive responsibility in teams. Through this combination, students qualify themselves for high-level involvement in ongoing transformative processes across a number of socially relevant industries that simultaneously demand individuals with extensive knowledge bases and developed leadership qualities.

Wie kann ich bei euch studieren?

Studying at Karlshochschule is characterized by interactivity. The aim of every learning session is the prioritization of smallscale group work, developing critical and analytical approaches amplified by intense exposure to the diverse perspectives that stem from our international community. We believe that knowledge is best acquired and deepened when it can literally be lived and experienced, for example through simulation games, current case studies, blended learning, excursions, or practical presentations by guest speakers with real-world experiences. Lectures are not about "reading out" but about teaching and engaging through open dialogue and exchange.

Wann sollte ich bei euch nicht studieren?

If you are uninterested in studying in an environment where high levels of participation and engagement are a necessity to keep up, the Karls is not for you. In our institution, an "anonymous" study experience is not possible as we need every student's engagement to maintain our didactic model of small groups engaging in discussion and debate. Our students need to show up every day, ready to engage with their peers on complex topics that go up to an international scale. This demands a high level of motivation from the students, who need to commit to engagement.
